





## XVI CONGRESS IN COPENHAGEN DENMARK

### Getting from the Airport to Copenhagen and the venues

Below is a transport map for greater Copenhagen. Regional trains run from the airport to Copenhagen Central Station every 10-20 minutes during the day. Metro trains run from the airport to *Nørreport* station and continue to *Forum* and *Frederiksberg* stations.



## How to find your hotel or hostel, and get from there to the venues

### **Central Copenhagen**

All of the hotels below are close to the centre of Copenhagen, and within walking distance of Copenhagen Main Station and the Imperial Cinema.

#### **DanHostel Copenhagen**

*H. C. Andersens Boulevard 50, DK-1553 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33118585*

Close to *Langebro* bridge, ca. 15 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. To get to the Panum institute, walk to the town hall square and take bus 6A.

#### **Grand Hotel**

*Vesterbrogade 9, DK-1620 København, Tel. 33156690*

4 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from near the hotel to the Panum Institute.

#### **Hotel Danmark**

*Vester Voldgade 89, DK-1552 Copenhagen K, Tel. 33114806*

Close to the town hall and Tivoli, about 10 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from the town hall square to the Panum Institute.

#### **Imperial Hotel**

*Vester Farimagsgade 9, DK-1606 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33128000*

Next to *Vesterport* S-station, 6 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from *Vesterport* station to the Panum Institute.

#### **Norlandia Mercur Hotel**

*Vester Farimagsgade 17, DK-1606 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33125711*

2 minutes walk from *Vesterport* S-station, 8 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from *Vesterport* station to the Panum Institute.

#### **Norlandia Richmond Hotel**

*Vester Farimagsgade 33, DK-1606 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33123366*

3 minutes walk from *Vesterport* S-station, 9 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from *Vesterport* station or the town hall square to the Panum Institute.

#### **Scandic Webers**

*Vesterbrogade 11A, DK-1620 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33311432*

5 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from near the hotel to the Panum Institute.

#### **The Square**

*Rådhuspladsen 14, DK-1550 Copenhagen V, Tel. 33381200*

On the town hall square, about 8 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station. Bus 6A runs from the town hall square to the Panum Institute.

#### **Wakeup Copenhagen**

*Carsten Niebuhrs Gade 11, 1577 Copenhagen V, Tel. 44800000*

About 10 minutes walk from Copenhagen Main Station, 8 minutes from *Dybbølsbro* S-station. To reach the Panum institute, you can either walk to Copenhagen Main Station and take bus 6A, or take bus 5A to *Nørreport* station, where busses 6A, 42, 43, 184, 185 and 150S run to the Panum Institute.

### **Hotels outside the city centre**

#### **Hotel CABINN Metro**

*Anne Jacobsens Allé 2, DK-2300 Copenhagen S, Tel. 32465700*

Close to the Fields shopping centre, next to *Ørestad* Metro and rail station. There are direct regional trains to *Ørestad* rail station from the airport, and the Metro line runs from *Ørestad* to *Nørreport* station, where busses 6A, 42, 43, 184, 185 and 150S run to the Panum Institute. To reach the Imperial cinema, you can take the Metro from *Ørestad* to *Nørreport* station, and then take any south-bound S-train 1 stop to *Vesterport* station.

#### **Radisson Blu Falkoner Hotel**



About 4 minutes walk from *Frederiksberg* Metro station (you can take the Metro directly from the airport). Bus 18 runs from opposite the hotel to *Tagensvej*, where it is a 5 minute walk to the Panum Institute. To reach the Imperial cinema, you can take the Metro 2 stop from *Frederiksberg* to *Nørreport* station, and then take any south-bound S-train 1 stop to *Vesterport* station.

#### **Hotel CABINN Scandinavia**

*Vodroffsvej 55, DK-1900 Frederiksberg, Tel. 35361111*

About 2 minutes walk from *Forum* Metro station (you can take the Metro directly from the airport). Bus 3A runs from west of *Forum* Metro station to the Panum Institute. To reach the Imperial cinema, you can take the Metro 1 stop from *Forum* to *Nørreport* station, and then take any south-bound S-train 1 stop to *Vesterport* station.



# Getting around in the city

Below is a transport map of central Copenhagen with the venues and the Odd follow palace marked.

Bus 6A is particularly useful, as it links many of the hotels, the Imperial Cinema and the Panum Institute. *Nørreport* station is a very useful interchange, where S-trains, regional trains, busses and Metro all converge. Tickets for public transport are valid on all forms of transport (except taxis). All delegates (but not accompanying persons) will get a 10-ride "klippekort" for transport in the central Copenhagen region. Each time you put the card into a clipping machine (on train/Metro platforms, or near the entrance of busses), you can ride anywhere in the central Copenhagen region for one hour.



## Getting to and around the congress venue

### Imperial Cinema

The presidential welcome and the keynote address on Monday August 9 will be held at the **Imperial Cinema**, Ved Vesterport 4. (see map of Copenhagen page 10). The Imperial cinema is located adjacent to **Vesterport** S-train Station, which can be reached by bus lines 5A, 6A, 12, 14, 15, 29, 30, 40, 47, 66, 67 and 68 as well. It is also within walking distance of many of the Congress hotels.

### The Panum Institute

The Panum Institute, Blegdamsvej 3, DK-2200 Copenhagen N, houses the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Copenhagen. It is located close to central Copenhagen on the border between the Nørrebro and Østerbro districts, and is within walking distance (15-20 min) of *Nørreport* Station, from where there are also bus links (bus no. 6A, 42, 43, 150S, 184 and 185). Buses stop at "Blegdamsvej/Rigshospital", opposite the Panum institute. To make your way into the building, walk down Blegdamsvej, and follow the signs to the main entrance ("Hovedindgang"). Once inside, make your way up the spiral staircase (or take the lift one floor) where you'll find the registration desk.
